

Can you find all 10 Nesting Boxes?



Trees 1 & 2 near the end of Iveson Place.

1. The nesting box here is suitable for small parrots. We're hoping some red capped parrots might use it—they have been seen nearby .
2. This box is suitable for owls or ducks. These birds like to have less canopy around the box, so there is a clear flight path in.

Refer to the map on the other flyer for locations!



3. "Dougie's Patch" (near the drain where Dougie the Dugite lives). This box is in a Cape Lilac tree. It is suitable for Medium sized Mammals (eg. possums). It needed a spot where the box could be up among the canopy and there was a fair bit of canopy cover.
4. (Below) Near the Water Corp pump station, at the start of the limestone track. This box is suitable for Medium sized Parrots.



5. (Above). At the edge of the grassed area, at the edge of the swamp . This is on your left, if you are walking from the end of Iveson Place. It's where the grassed area widens out ,about 70m past the willow tree. This box is suitable for ducks or owls.



6. (Above and left) This tree is a few metres into the bush off the grassed area. Opposite the last house before the Hardy Rd carpark. Photo above is the view from the “entrance”. This box is suitable for possums. Possums love to come in from the top and slide in backwards, “like stuffing themselves in a laundry chute”.

7. (Below) Near the bottom of the path down from the Hardy Rd carpark, to the drain. On the left of the path. This box is suitable for Large Parrots.



Trees 8, 9 and 10 are all along the path next to the Hardy Rd drain (where the path is flat). They are all within about 25m of the bollards and gate, on the river side of the gate.

If walking towards the river, boxes 9 & 10 are on your left. 9 is closer to the gate than 10.

8 is on your right, across the drain. It is suitable for small Parrots.

9 is suitable for medium sized parrots.

10 is suitable for large parrots.
